WHO ARE VICTIMS AND SURVIVORS?

The Victims and Survivors (Northern Ireland) Order 2006 defines victims and survivors as:

- Those who have been bereaved as a result of a Conflict/Troubles-related incident.
- Those who have been injured as a result of a Conflict/Troubles-related incident (physically or psychologically).
- Those who provide care for others who have been injured in this way.

Befriending Services	Do you feel isolated? Our service providers offer outreach services and emotional support that may be relevant to you.
Complementary Therapies	Do you want to relax your mind and body in a stress-free environment? Our service providers offer therapies such as reflexology and aromatherapy, which can help you relax and improve your sense of well being.
Personal and Professional Development	Do you want to learn new skills, or participate in activities that bring you into contact with other people? Our service providers offer various classes and activities that may be of interest to you.
Social Support	Do you want to come together with others, to remember and commemorate important dates and memories that you share? Or do you want to enjoy the company of others who have had similar experiences to you? Our service providers organise activities that may be of interest to you.
Talking Therapies	Do you need to talk to someone? Our service providers offer talking therapies that include counselling, life coaching and Cognitive Behavioural Therapy.
Transgenerational Services	Looking for services and activities that take into account family dynamics and relationships across the generations? Our service providers deliver programmes that may be relevant to you.
Truth, Justice & Acknowledgement Activities	Are you interested in the work of 'dealing with the past' in relation to the Conflict / the Troubles? Are historical investigations important to you? Or do you want to know more about truth, justice and acknowledgement, and what these ideas might mean for you? Our service providers have experience of working in this area.
Welfare Support	Do you need help to make sense of welfare support? Not sure what you're entitled to? Our service providers offer support and guidance regarding benefits claims and related issues.
